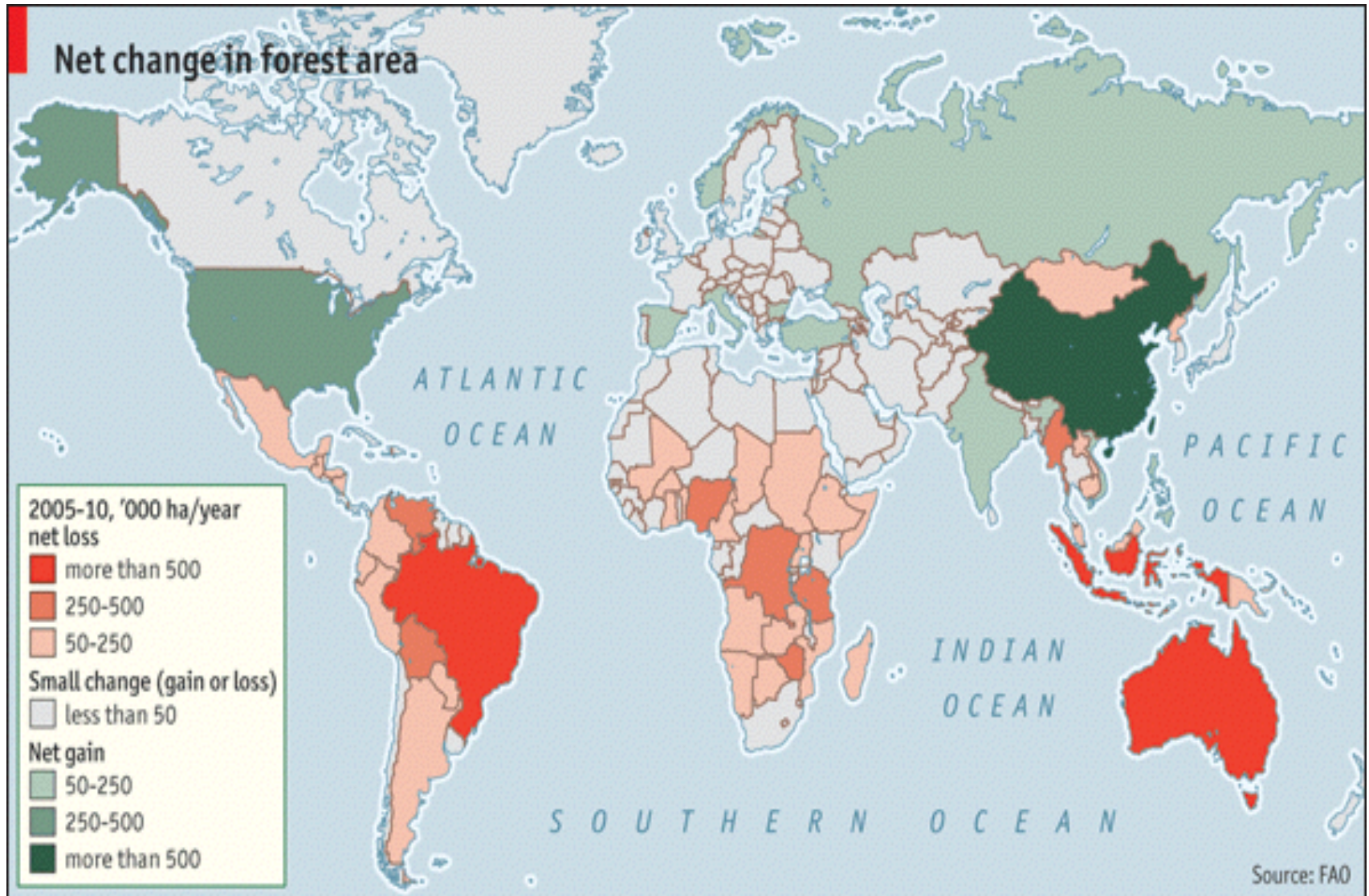

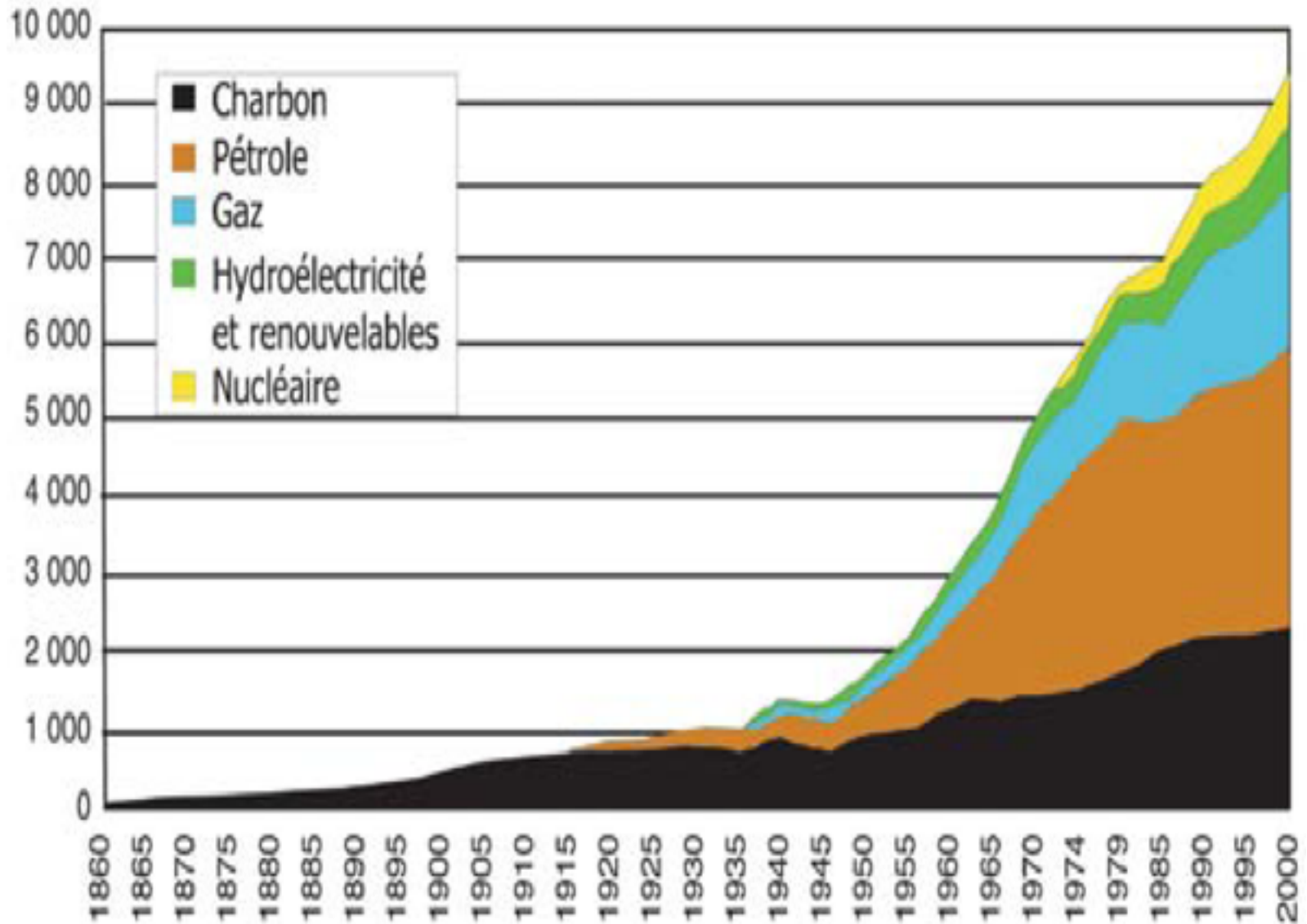

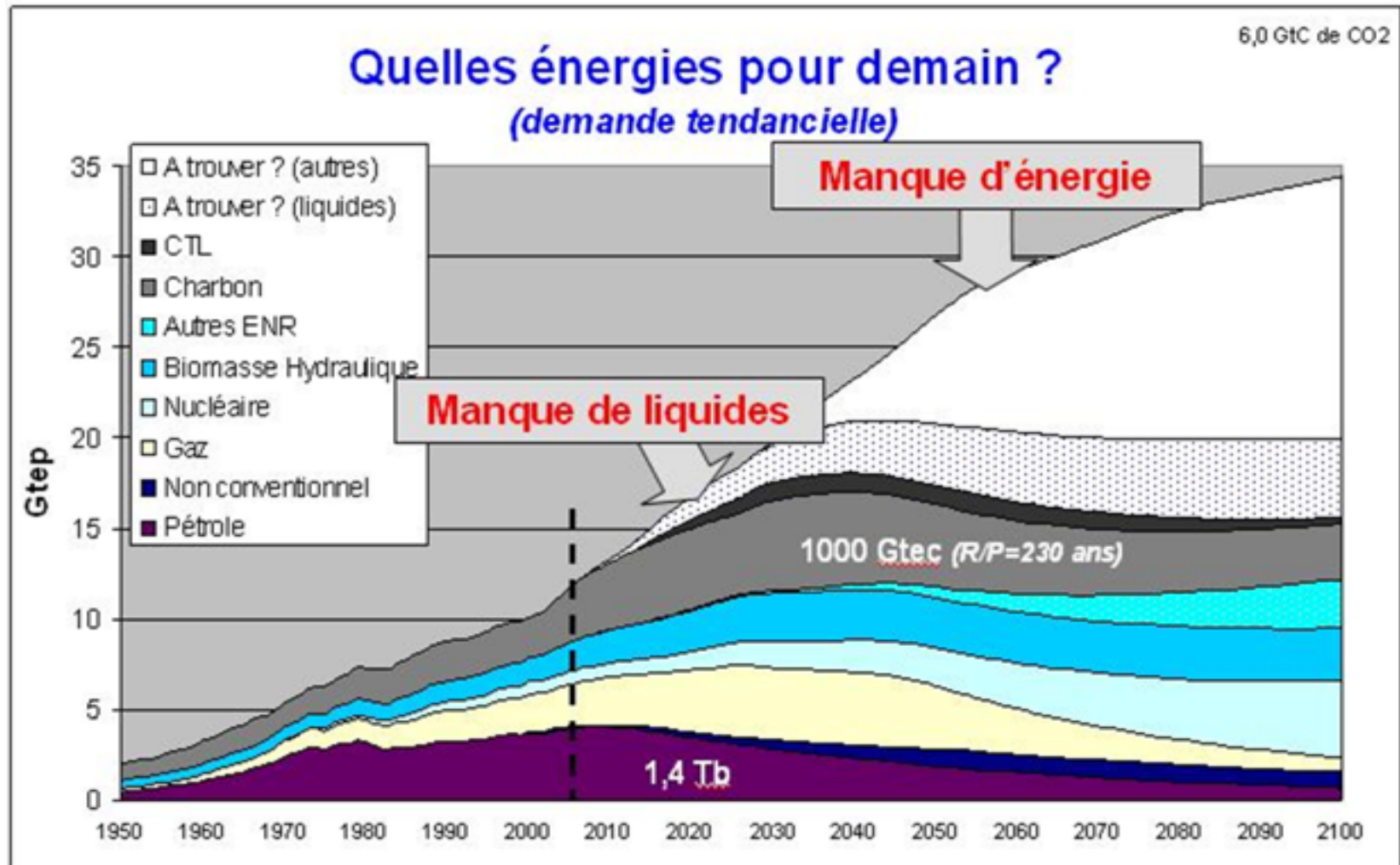

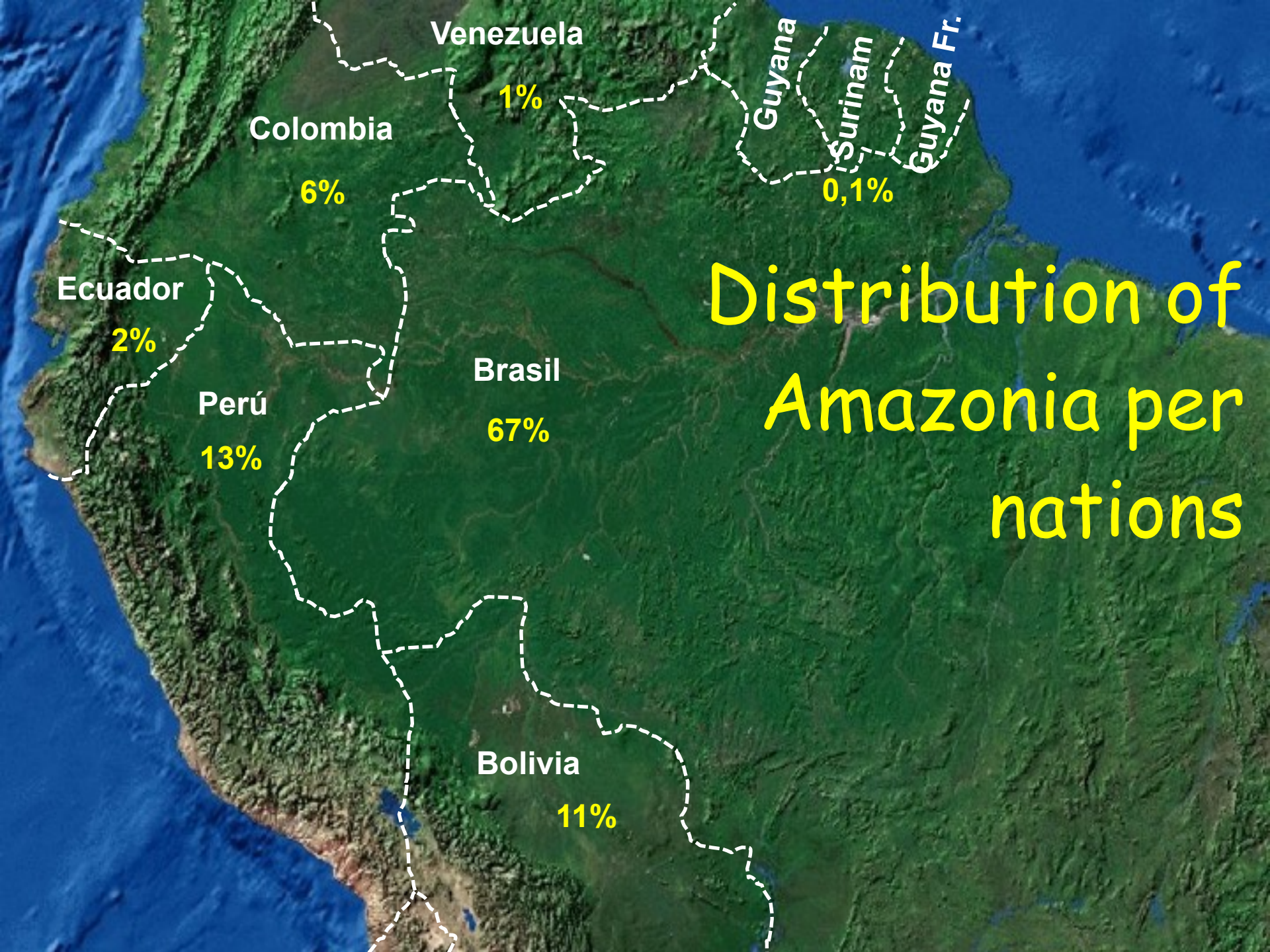

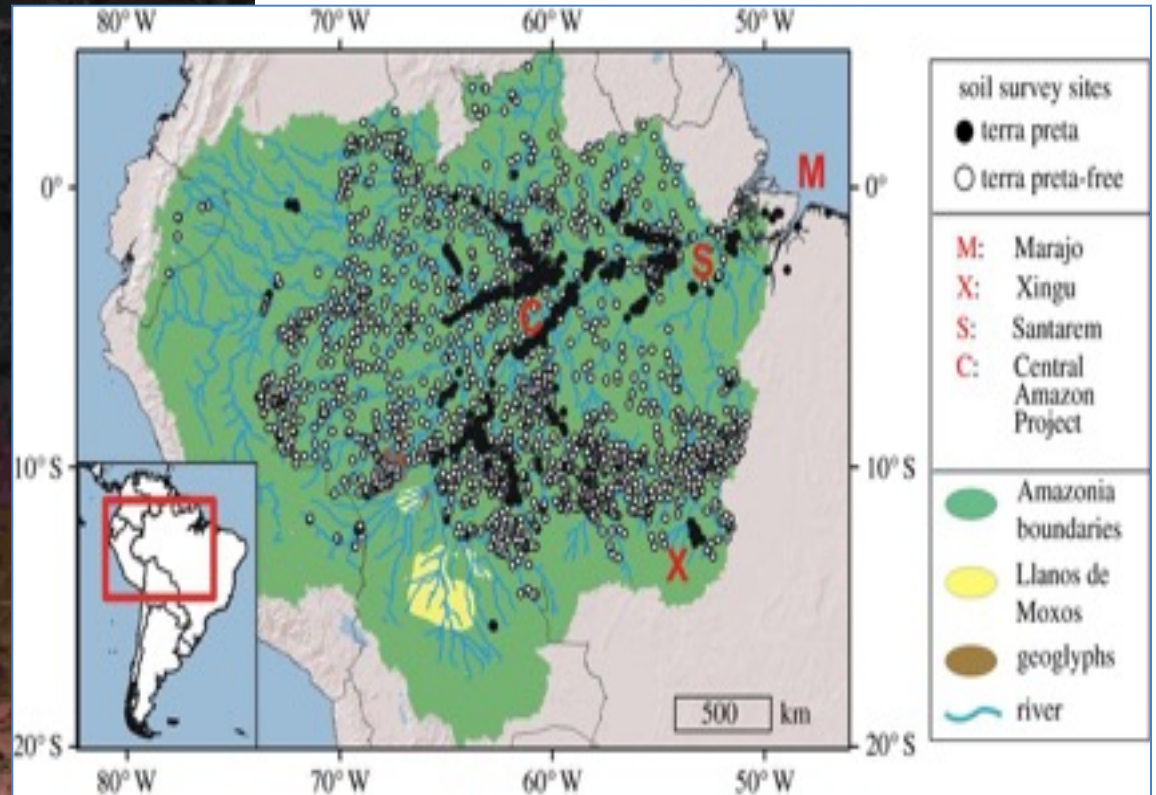

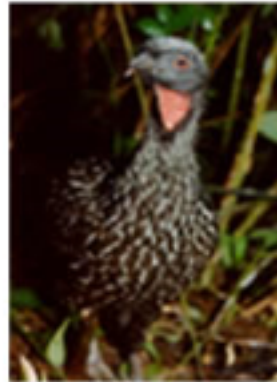
Amazonia: 34 % of primary forest of the world

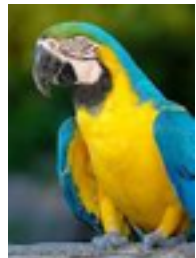
Amazonía: 1/3 of biodiversity and 30% of the genetic stock of the Planet

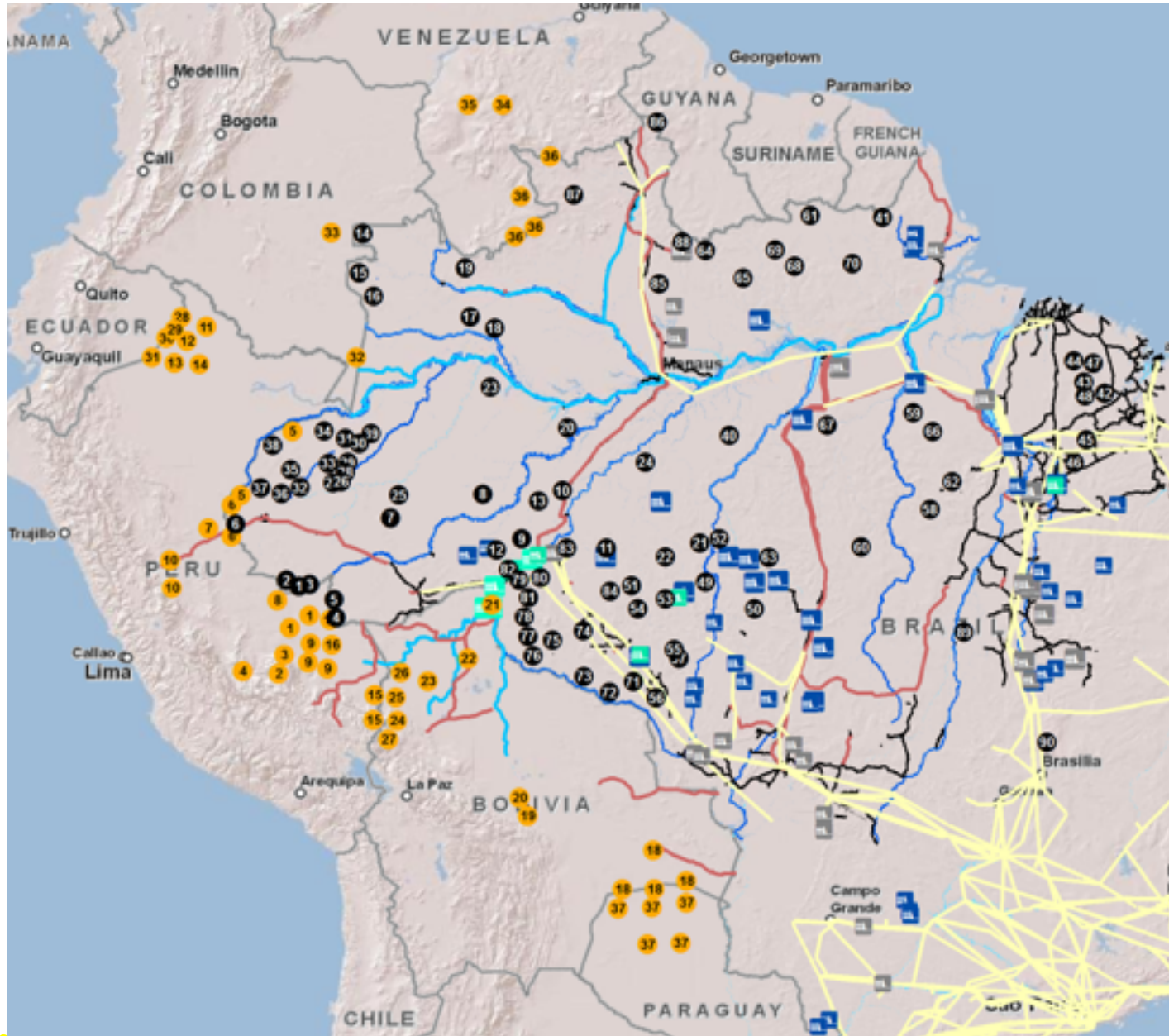

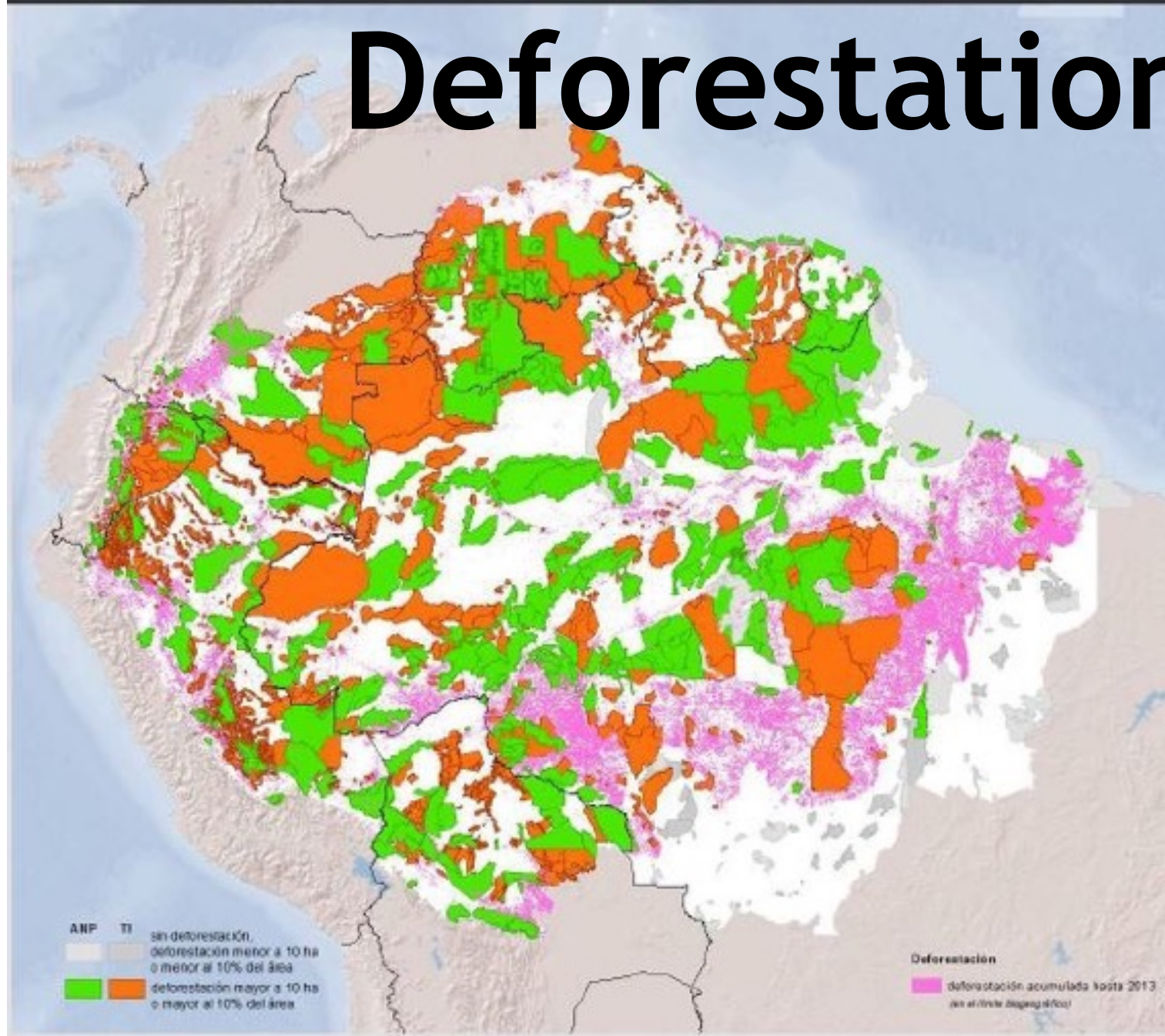

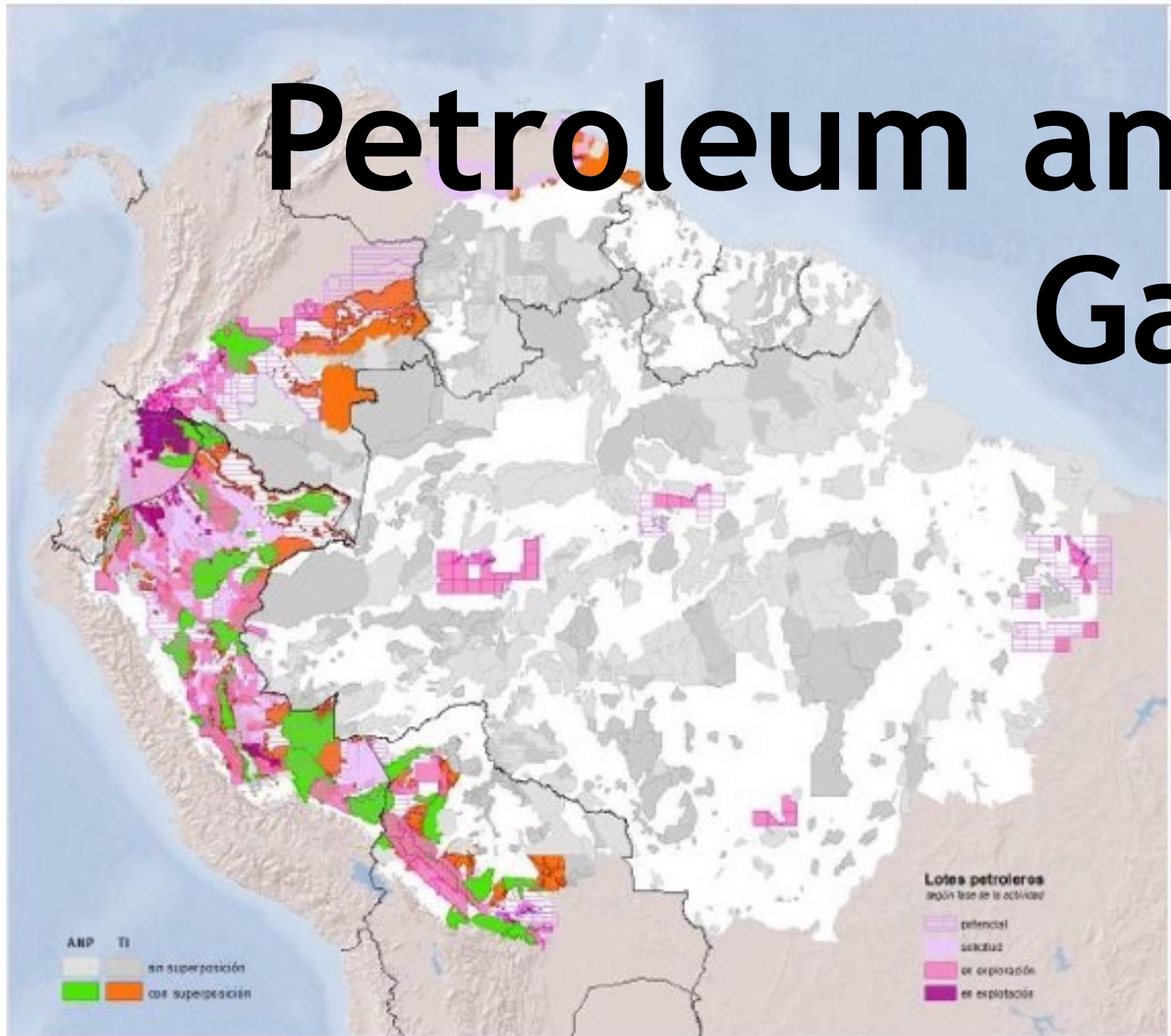

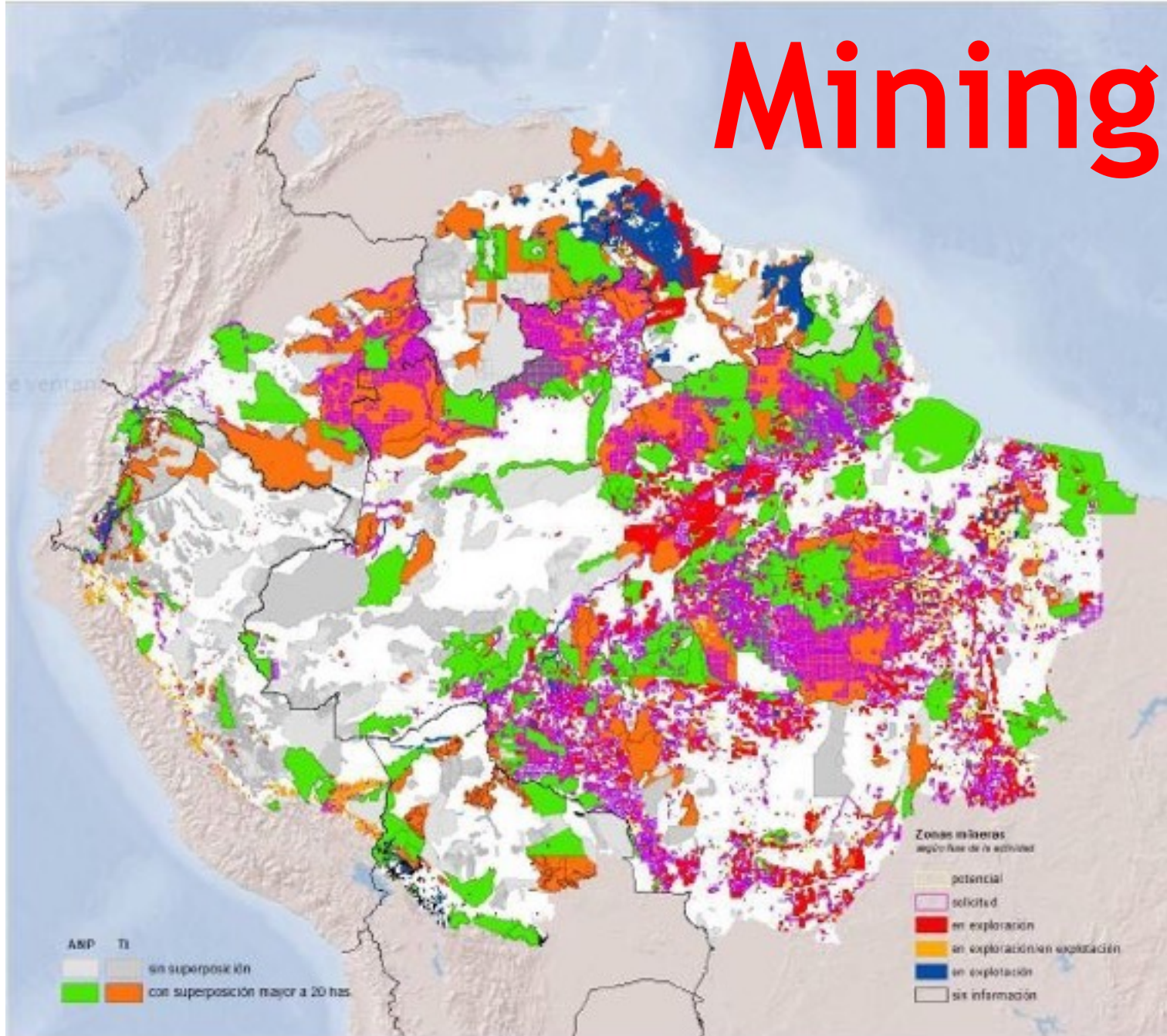

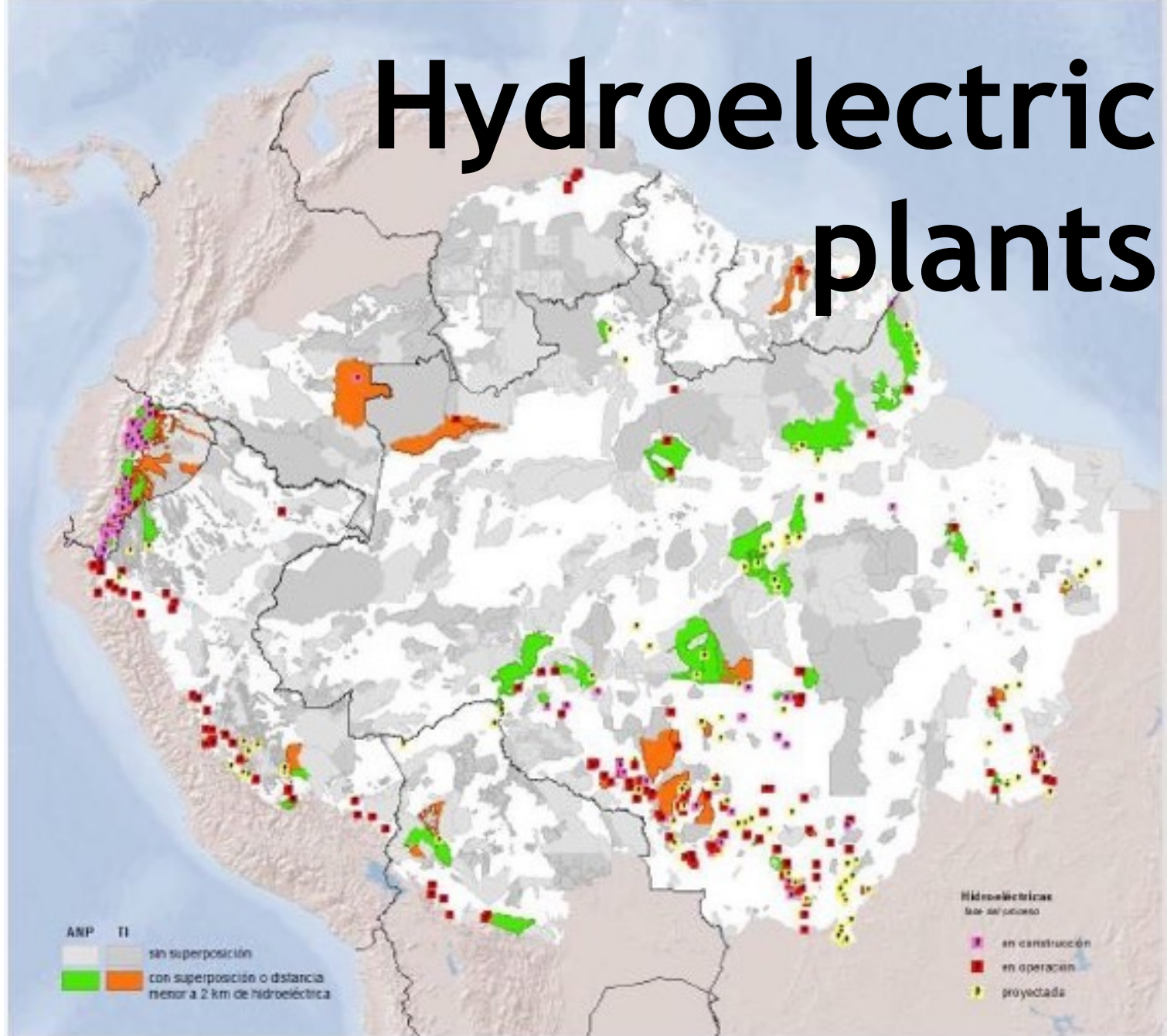

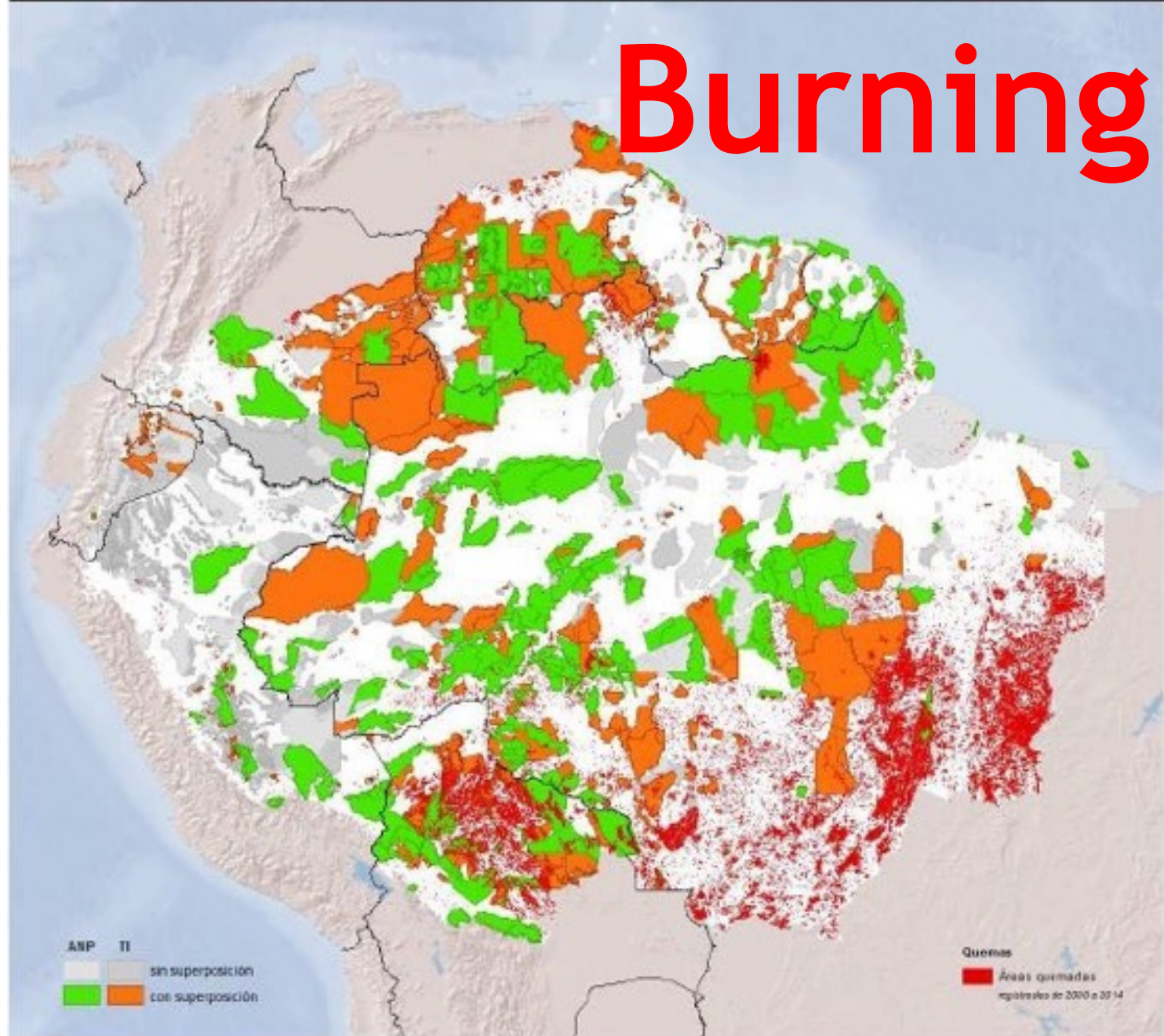
